



## Table: U.S. Senators' Votes on High-Ranking 2013 Latino Nominees and Hispanic Population by State

In order to confirm nominees, Senators must first vote to invoke cloture (a procedural vote to end debate) and then cast their final votes on the nominee. The table below includes Hispanic demographics by state from the U.S. Census alongside both the cloture and the final votes for the confirmation of U.S. Secretary of the Department of Labor Thomas Perez and Katherine Archuleta, the newly-confirmed Director of the U.S. Office of Personnel Management.
