## Re: NHLA Support for John King for Secretary of U.S. Department of Education

Dear Majority Leader McConnell and Minority Leader Reid:

On behalf of the National Hispanic Leadership Agenda (NHLA), a coalition of 40 leading national Latino nonpartisan civil rights and advocacy organizations, we write to urge you to support John King for Secretary of Education.

Latino children make up over twenty-five percent of all public school students in the United States, underscoring the need for leadership reflective of the changing demographics of our country. As a Latino and African American, Mr. King would bring an important perspective to the role of Secretary of Education. Having started his career teaching high school civics in Puerto Rico, Mr. King understands the diverse educational experiences in America, and the necessity for the Department of Education to meet the needs of all American children.

Furthermore, we owe it to our country's 50.1 million public school students to confirm the most qualified individual to take the helm of leadership and we believe that Mr. King is exceptionally qualified for the position of Secretary of Education. He is an attorney with a J.D. from Yale Law School and has a doctorate in Education from Columbia University. He has spent the last year as the Principal Senior Advisor to former Secretary of Education Arne Duncan, and before that was the Commissioner of Education in New York.

NHLA strongly supports the nomination of John King as the next Secretary of Education, and urges your vote to confirm.
